

## THE PROJECT OVERVIEW

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

In 2020, Eastgate Shopping Centre in Bedfordview, embarked on a Solar Power installation to reduce its overall energy consumption (this was Phase 1).

Phase 2 commenced in 2023, to add additional power generation to the rooftop parking. Covering 28 100sqm (roughly 4 football fields), Eastgate Mall has close to 13 675 solar panels, equating to 35.04% of the energy the mall requires to run on a daily basis.

The structure has a two-fold purpose, namely to support the solar panels as well as provide covered parking on the rooftop level.


